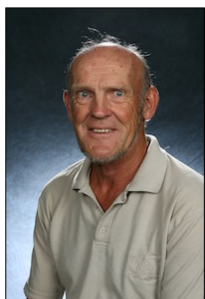

**Meet Head Coaches Harry Parker and Liz O’Leary
And The Crimson Crew Coaching Staff**



The Legendary Harry Parker, now in his 50th season as the Thomas Bolles Head Coach of Men's Crew at Harvard, is considered one of the most accomplished rowing coaches in the history of the sport. After being promoted from interim head coach to head coach in 1963 following Harvard's victory over Yale University in the Harvard-Yale Race, Parker's crews have achieved unprecedented success: 21 undefeated seasons; eight official and eight unofficial national championships, and a 42-7 record over Yale in the Harvard-Yale race.

Under Parker, Harvard crews have competed internationally at the 1968 Olympics and the 1967 World Rowing Championships. He was named the men's Olympic coach for 1972, where he led the U.S. eight to a silver medal in Munich, Germany. He also served as coach of the first U.S. women's crew to compete in the world championships, winning a medal in 1975. Parker later coached the U.S. women's eight to a bronze medal at the 1976 Olympic Games in Montreal.

Liz O’Leary, Head Coach of Women’s Crew, is in her 25th season guiding the Radcliffe heavyweight crews to the pinnacle of women's collegiate rowing, and made Radcliffe a perennial contender for national championships. The recent run of excellence--her 2003 team captured the NCAA title, and her 2005 varsity followed that up with a bronze-medal finish--makes this one of the most successful eras of an already-proud tradition of Black and White crews.
