On June 1, 2011, Steven High became executive director of The John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art. He is responsible for all aspects of operations at the Museum of Art, Ringling Circus Museum including the Tibbals Learning Center, the Cà d'Zan mansion, the Historic Asolo Theater, the Johnson-Blalock Education Center, and 66 acres of historic grounds and gardens.

He may describe plans to build upon the magnificent assets of the art collection, programming, educational opportunities, buildings, library, grounds and events like "Beyond Bling: Voices of Hip-Hop in Art."

High holds a Master of Arts degree in art history from Williams College in Williamstown, Mass., and a Bachelor of Arts degree in art history from Antioch College in Yellow Springs, Ohio. He also earned an MBA from Virginia Commonwealth University.

From 2007-2011, High served as director and CEO of the Telfair Museums in Savannah, Ga., which ended 2010 with the highest attendance in its history at 180,000 visitors. There he led a five-year strategic plan that resulted in reinforcing the diversity and the synergy of the Telfair's three sites: Telfair Academy, Owens-Thomas House, and the new Jepson Center for the Arts. Since 1986, he has curated 41 exhibitions on contemporary art with a particular focus on contemporary international art, published 19 catalog essays and three magazine articles.
