

"THINK BIG Lecturer" Dr. Andrew Berry REVEALS ALL !!!

Harvard students voted Andrew Berry to be one of the presenters at "2010 Harvard Thinks Big", student-organized discussions that pair leading lecturers with eager listeners. Students wanted to "to be inspired by hearing incredible professors talk about the things they know best." As an animated lecturer, Berry moved around the stage in a brief "drunken" stumble to help illustrate the confused arc of an

important genetic mutation in human evolution.

Born in London in 1963, he is an Alfred Wallace historian and lecturer on Organismic and Evolutionary Biology at Harvard. He earned a degree in zoology from Oxford and a PhD in evolutionary genetics from Princeton. He is the editor of a collection of the writings of Alfred Russel Wallace ("Infinite Tropics", Verso 2002), the Victorian biologist who co-discovered natural selection with Charles Darwin.

As an educator, his mission is to demystify and popularize the

most important and most misinterpreted of all biological ideas—evolution. He has published on New Guinea's Giant Rats, Atlantic island's mice, Far East aphids, and the fruit fly. He was co-author, with James Watson, of the history and impact of modern genetics, to mark the 50th anniversary of Watson & Crick's discovery of the double helix (DNA, Knopf 2003). Berry has worked on several major TV series for PBS: "Race: The Power of An Illusion", "DNA" a 5-
