Col. Mike Pheneger, USA (Ret) spent 30 years on active duty as a US Army Intelligence Officer. He served in a variety of assignments including Director of Intelligence for US Special Operations Command, Deputy Director of Intelligence for US Central Command, and multiple combat tours. He had overseas assignments in Germany, Vietnam, Korea, Panama, and the Middle East.

After military retirement he developed training programs for adult professionals for the University of South Florida's Professional and Workforce Development Division. He teaches courses on the Bill of Rights, The Constitution, Terrorism and Geo-Politics for Learning-In-Retirement programs in Tampa and Sarasota. He received the Open Source Solutions' Golden Candle Award in 1995.

As the President of the American Civil Liberties Union of Florida, he speaks frequently on issues involving civil liberties and national security, and the ethical and constitutional aspects of intelligence collection and operations. He served as an expert witness in a case to enjoin the Tampa Sports Authority from conducting pat-down searches as a condition of attending NFL football games.
